Montessori Center School provides thematic camps for children from 3 to 12 years old. Our summer sessions are a great continuance of the school year, enriching your child's education with diverse and fun programs. If you are curious about Montessori education or interested in challenging your child's imagination this summer, explore one or more of these sessions.

Mission Statement

Our mission is to offer a Montessori education that encourages intellectual, social, physical, creative, and moral development, preparing students for academic excellence, confident, lifelong learning and responsible, caring lives.

Statement of Educational Philosophy

Montessori's philosophy respects and embraces the natural worlds and the panorama of cultures, knowledge and arts. It respects both the individual and the community in its efforts to provide well-rounded education with the following emphases:

- **Intellectual:** Hands-on material and teacher-facilitated learning creates a stimulating curriculum, responsive to individual learning styles and developmental stages ("sensitive periods"), that treats the child as both teacher and student, that fosters order, independence and creativity in thinking, and that provides a strong basis for scholastic ability and for optimizing intellectual potential.
- **Social:** Adults and children in multi-age classrooms act as models for and encouragers of appropriate choices and behaviors that honor the feelings of self and others, that demonstrate mutual respect for members of the classroom and global communities, and that foster qualities of leadership and group contribution.
- **Physical:** Participation in play, fine and gross motor activities, fitness and performing arts reinforces the mind-body connection and enhances agility.
- **Creative:** Exposure to visual and performing arts curricula strengthens, broadens and enhances intellectual and cultural development.
- **Moral:** Opportunities exist to learn and use ethical judgment and civility within the family-like order of the classroom, so that universal values such as respect, responsibility, honesty, self-discipline, compassion, perseverance and loyalty are supported.

These camps are suitable for Primary students age 3-5 yrs old. Current Pre-Primary students (Gold and White Door) promoting to Primary in the fall should register for Pre-Primary camps. Students promoting to Lower Elementary (1st grade) in the fall should enroll in Elementary classes. Naptime is available for campers from 1:00 - 2:30 p.m. Please register for naps in advance.

Session 1	June 11 - June 14	Sports Camp	\$270
Let's focus on movement, fitness and exercise with Paula Ludwig! This is a fun way for children to experience a variety of different sports, games and activities. Children will gain a basic understanding in different sports while practicing fundamental movement skills. We will also be encouraging good sportsmanship and teamwork while having fun in the sun!			
Session 2	June 17 - June 21	Animal Art Camp	\$335
Students will create their own portfolio full of animal inspired art with Krista Williams. We will use a variety of mediums including collage, acrylic and watercolors to name a few. Children will learn fun facts about the animals we paint!			
Session 3	June 24 - June 28	Tie Dye Camp	\$335
Join Krista Williams in making the fun and funky art of tie dye! Children will make their own tie dye creations. We will also explore and experiment with color by mixing, dying and separating colors through a variety of brightly colored activities.			
Session 4	July 1 - July 3 (closed July 4 & 5)	Mind, Body, Self	\$200
Learn yoga through movement games and make healthy snacks with Krista Williams. Children will create healthy smoothies as we nourish our minds and bodies! We will learn new ways to use our breath in connection to our bodies. Keep moving this summer in new and interesting ways!			
Session 5	July 8 - July 12	Ceramics with Suzanne	\$335
Children will enjoy a fun time with Suzanne Hawtrey, our Art Specialist, using clay to build pinch pots, slab vases and vessels made from coils. After clay projects have been completed the children will be given free time to build whatever they choose! These skills are related to the proper construction of ceramic forms, so that the children are successful in their designs. .			
Session 6	July 15 - July 19	Art in Nature	\$335
Return of the "Great Bug Hunt!" Children will explore nature each day with Suzanne Hawtrey, our Art Specialist, and come back to the studio to document discoveries through art. Paints, pastels and markers will be used in the studio to create group murals, nature journals and nature collages. During nature walks children will be encouraged to explore the world around them.			
Session 7	July 22 - July 26	Global Beats Musical Journey	\$335
Join Trudie Olsen-Curtis on a magical musical adventure experiencing the world through international songs, rhythms and movement. Drums and percussion instruments will be provided, and we will be creating simple rhythm instruments and multicultural crafts.			
Session 8	July 29 - August 2	International Cooking	\$335
Join Roma Garcia in making healthy and delicious summer snacks from all over the world. We will spend each day looking at the most popular summertime dishes from around the globe. The students will participate in the preparation, cooking and clean up. They will also be doing engaging activities to promote their understanding of the cultures, textures, and countries from which the food originated.

These camps are suitable for Elementary students, entering 1st through 3rd grade in the fall. Traditional Montessori materials will be available to practice academic skills.

Session 1	June 11 - June 14	Dribble, Pass, Shoot	\$270
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Learn a new sport or improve at one you already enjoy with Kimmy Sanchez! Basketball, soccer, gaga ball and more will be played during this camp. Be prepared to run around, practice sportsmanship and have fun in the sun. When we need to rest and refuel our energy, we will take the fun inside to enjoy some board games, simple crafts and stories.

Session 2	June 17 - June 21	Global Beats Rhythmic Adventure	\$335
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Have you ever wanted to learn to drum? Join Trudie Olsen-Curtis and explore international rhythms like clave, flamenco, reggae, rock and samba on various types of drums and percussion instruments. We will also discover fun ways to create rhythms with body percussion, clapping games and cups. Drums and percussion instruments will be provided. We will make simple rhythm instruments and create multicultural crafts.

Session 3	June 24 - June 28	Time Travel Camp	\$335
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Join Irene Morales in this journey through time and space! We will create our own time travel machine as a craft project and experience what life was like in the past or what it might be like in the future. We will begin our adventures by traveling to Prehistoric times, where we will learn how cave-men made useful tools and met their basic needs. Our final and most exciting destination will be our trip to "the future" (year 2500). We will predict and invent futuristic food such as: Ice-cube Space Ice-cream and Giggly-Jiggly Jello. Maybe we can even come up with our own "futuristic house!" Come travel with us!

Session 4	July 1 - July 3(closed July 4 & 5)	Pizza & Pasta Mania	\$200
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Irene Morales will lead this busy week, where students will be making fun projects using all different kinds of pasta and dried noodles. We will first sort, color and learn the names of the pasta varieties such as lasagna, macaroni, spaghetti, ravioli, penne, fettuccine, fusilli, farfalle, conchiglie, etc. Then we all make crafts and projects with them. Some of the projects include: pasta rainbow, noodle necklaces, pasta dinosaurs, pasta flowers or butterflies, pasta wind chimes, rain and other original structures. The highlight will be cooking and eating pasta and pizza dishes. Yum!! Let's have fun!

Session 5	July 8 - July 12	The Wonder of Water	\$335
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In this exciting camp with Irene Morales, students will have a blast exploring, learning, cooking, experimenting, dancing and playing with water. What is water? Where did it come from? What is it made of? In order to answer some of these questions, we will perform a variety of water science experiments. We will also have water stations set-up outdoors for water play. We will probably wear shorts or swimsuits every day! Many games will be played outside as we experiment with water! We will also make our own tin foil boats to sail outdoors. Join us!!!

Session 6	July 15 - July 19	Ukelele Adventure	\$335
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We will learn simple songs, chords and beginning strumming patterns on the ukelele. We will also create rhythms with body percussion, clapping games and cups. Ukeleles and percussion instruments will be provided. Trudie Olsen-Curtis will be teaching this musical class.

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Come join Kathy Finck! Enjoy playing Uno, Chess, Mancala, Batik and more. Have you ever tried walking on stilts? Or dreamed of becoming a pogo stick master? You will have the opportunity to prepare healthy snacks, and practice cooking skills.
